District secretaries, who provide key assistance to the governors in district operations, have important roles and responsibilities that are different from those of assistant governors. Without district secretaries, the districts cannot implement the District Leadership Plan effectively.

Therefore, district secretaries' important role and responsibilities should be clearly mentioned in the District Leadership Plan and publicized among Rotarians in the districts in order to promote the effective implementation of the plan.
