

OPPOSITION TO LEGISLATION ADOPTED BY THE 2022 COUNCIL ON LEGISLATION

In order for a Council action to be suspended, clubs representing at least 5% of votes entitled to be cast by clubs must file their opposition to the item of legislation. For 2022, RI needed to receive 2,632 votes in opposition in order to suspend a Council action.
