

## **Council on Resolutions**

The Council on Resolutions meets online every year to vote on proposed resolutions. Resolutions are requests to the Board or the Trustees to take an action that is outside the purview of the constitutional documents. Ideally, a resolution should affect the Rotary world, rather than address local or administrative issues.

Representatives from all Rotary districts vote on resolutions prop Board, and the general council or conference of RIBI. Adopted res by the RI Board or The Rotary Foundation Truston Use the link in the text to see the resolutions and urgent enactments. Then sign in to comment and vote.

The Council on Positions will take place 15 October through 15 November. You can view resolutions beginning 1 October. Voting will close 15 November at 23:59 Chicago time (UTC-6). The results will be published by 20 November. Any Rotarian can view the resolutions and the results, but only representatives can vote.

## **Council on Resolutions**

The Council on Resolutions meets online each year. Representatives from all of Rotary's districts vote on resolutions proposed by clubs, districts, the RI Board of Directors, and the General Council or Conference of RIBI, as well as urgent enactments proposed by the RI Board. The RI Board will consider all resolutions that the Council adopts. Adopted urgent enactments amend Rotary's constitutional documents.

Each Council representative may submit up to 3 comments. Each comment is limited to 500 characters.


