PURPOSE AND EFFECT

To revitalize any club and maximize its effectiveness, strong relationships must 17 18 be maintained amongst the club's members. Frequent opportunities for fellowship are important in this respect as these tend to result in greater 19 compatibility among club members. Stronger relationships and improved 20 understanding will lead to a more open exchange of ideas within the club, as well 21 as to the development of better club leadership and enhanced service 22 opportunities for its members. 23 24

Conducting frequent meetings and following Rotary protocols will help to foster a 25 strong culture of Rotary within each club, and the resulting increase in club 26 meeting attendance will positively impact long-term membership retention and 27 growth. 28
