To request the RI Board to consider officially recognizing Rotary Kids as a structured program of RI

1	WHEREAS, Rotary Kids is a program for pre-Interact youth, and
2 3 4 5 6	WHEREAS, the increased precocity and accelerated social development of young people in our society is attributable at least in part to their use of modern communications media, and
7 8 9	WHEREAS, youth within this age group are already beginning to develop a sense of social responsibility, and are receptive to volunteer-based activities that align with Rotary, and
10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, the adoption of such a program would help to rejuvenate Rotary's public image, as well as contribute to the future viability of Interact, Rotaract, and Rotary clubs, and
14 15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, a member of Rotary Kids will remain under the full supervision of the adult who introduces him or her to the sponsor Rotary club. This relationship is formalized in a document, signed by the sponsor, in which he/she releases RI from any and all ties with the sponsored child, and
19 20 21 22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, the induction of young people into Rotary Kids clubs can bring about growth of the sponsor clubs, as well as in contributions to The Rotary Foundation. As family and friends learn about our programs, they become active within their communities, contribute to and become members of Rotary, all of which has been demonstrated in the experience of the hundreds of Rotary Kids clubs already in existence, and
26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, Rotary Kids and programs like it are already in existence throughout the world, but they require the consistent oversight and support of RI, and
30 31 32	IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of RI consider officially recognizing Rotary Kids as a structured program of RI for children six to eleven years of age.

- 1 This proposal seeks to make Rotary Kids an official program of RI.
- 2
- 3 It will increase Rotary's membership and donations to The Rotary Foundation,
- 4 and revitalize the organization, thus helping to insure its survival into the future.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

- 5 If implemented, this resolution would result in an increase in expenses for RI. If
- 6 Rotary Kids is administered as a structured program, expenses are estimated to
- 7 be at US\$254,600 per year for two staff members, production of materials, and
- 8 postage. In addition, there is an initial cost of US\$20,000 for global trademark
- 9 research and registration.
