To request the RI Board to consider acknowledging the Waterton-Glacier International Peace Park Association's continued promotion of Rotary's commitment to peace

1 WHEREAS, Rotarians on both sides of the US and Canada border have
2 successfully lobbied their members and respective governments to approve the
3 establishment of the Waterton-Glacier International Peace Park, and

5 WHEREAS, they have also pledged their loyalty and allegiance to foster all
6 international relationships, and

8 WHEREAS, the Waterton-Glacier International Peace Park was established on 18
9 June 1932, and

11 WHEREAS, the Waterton-Glacier International Peace Park exemplifies Rotary's
12 area of focus - promoting peace

14 IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary
15 International consider acknowledging the Waterton-Glacier International Peace
16 Park Association's continued promotion of Rotary's commitment to peace.
