

RESOLUTION 21R-12

To request the RI Board consider eliminating the role of assistant coordinator

Proposer(s): Rotary Club of Piçarras, District 4652, Brazil

1 WHEREAS, there are a very large number of assistant coordinators in each
2 region, and their expenses are funded by RI, and

3
4 WHEREAS, the tasks of the assistant coordinators are often directed to only one
5 or two districts; an additional regional coordinator could just as effectively be
6 appointed in countries with larger geographical areas, and

7
8 WHEREAS, regional coordinators can easily keep in touch with the governors of
9 their areas to provide support and keep them informed about action strategies,
10 and

12 WHEREAS, assistant coordinators often fail to perform their assigned duties, and

13
14 WHEREAS, the costs of training, travel, and other expenses for assistant
15 coordinators are not justified by the level of service that they provide

16
17 IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary
18 International consider eliminating the role of assistant coordinator and
19 reassigning the duties associated with that role to regional coordinators.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

20 If implemented, this resolution would have no substantial financial impact on RI.
21 Assistant coordinators do not have a separate budget. Regional coordinators are
22 given a fixed budget regardless of how many assistant coordinators they have.
