To request the RI Board to consider commissioning a new musical piece representative of Rotary

12	WHEREAS, the Rotary anthem is often played at the beginning of large national
13 14	and international events, and even some Rotary club meetings, especially during induction ceremonies for new members, and

16	WHEREAS, the Rotary anthem should convey enthusiasm and the joy of belonging
17	to an international movement promoting peace

19	IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary
20	International consider issuing a call to composers, two or three of whom would be
21	commissioned to collaborate on a musical piece which appeals to all generations,
22	celebrates the cultural universality of each continent, and clearly reflects Rotary's
23	values. This new anthem should generate enthusiasm and affirm the joy of serving.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT

- Even if they acknowledge the solemn aspect of the current Rotary anthem, the vast majority of our members find it out of sync with our objectives as an organization. They believe this work does not suitably convey Rotary's values, is not sufficiently inspiring, especially to young people, and lacks universality.
- This new anthem should be more modern and better aligned with the aspirations of younger generations, incorporating musical stylistic elements from each of the five continents.
