To request the RI Board to consider maintaining a firm position on the prohibition of political subjects by RI

Proposer(s): Rotary Club of Tokyo Ochanomizu, District 2580, Japan

- WHEREAS, Article 14, Section 3(a) of the Standard Rotary Club Constitution states 1 2
- that a Rotary club "shall neither adopt nor circulate resolutions or opinions and
- shall not take action dealing with world affairs or international policies of a political 3 nature," and 4
- 5
- 6 WHEREAS, this prohibition of political subjects should, of course, also be applied to RI, which is an association of Rotary clubs, and 7 8
- WHEREAS, on February 24, 2022, the day after Russia invaded Ukraine, RI 9
- released a statement on My Rotary regarding the situation in Ukraine on behalf of 10 Rotary International, and 11
- 12
- WHEREAS, this statement violates the above provision as it clearly deals with a 13 political subject 14
- 15
- 16 IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary
- International consider maintaining a firm position on the prohibition of political 17 subjects by RI. 18

PURPOSE AND EFFECT

- The intent of this proposed resolution is neither to comment on the relative 19
- merits of the statement made by RI nor to take a particular side in this issue. 20
- 21
- The statement clearly violates the provision prohibiting comment by RI on 22
- subjects of a political nature and is therefore also in violation of the constitutional 23
- 24 documents. It is, quite simply, a question of organizational management.

- This resolution would allow reliable Board operation in accordance with the 26
- constitutional documents of RI. 27
