The RI Board has adopted a new DEI code of conduct that reflects Rotary's core values. The motto "One Profits Most Who Serves Best" may appear outdated or incompatible with this change.

- By designating "One Profits Most Who Serves Best" as an ideal or core value of 21 Rotary and grouping it together with similar sentiments expressed in the Four-22
- Way Test, the Object of Rotary, and the Five Avenues of Service, we can preserve 23
- 24 Rotary's tradition while simultaneously ensuring that RI remains diverse and
