To request the RI Board to consider ensuring that the general qualifications for membership on RI committees are reflective of Rotary's DEI statement

6	WHEREAS, English-language proficiency is currently a prerequisite for membership
7	on certain RI committees, and

9	WHEREAS, this requirement is contrary to Rotary's DEI statement and
10	significantly handicaps Rotarians who are non-native English speakers

12	IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary
13	International consider ensuring that the general qualifications for membership on
14	RI committees are reflective of Rotary's DEI statement.

## PURPOSE AND EFFECT

- The October 2022 Board decisions updated RI's committee structure, by setting up new committees and clarifying the relationships between them and their roles.
- For some committees, such as the Constitution and Bylaws Committee, the member qualifications include the ability to read and write in English.
- This excludes a large number of Rotarians whose native languages are completely different from English.
- To deny those with knowledge and capability the opportunities to serve on RI committees, because they are non-English speakers is contrary to the Rotary DEI statement.

  28 Removing this restriction would help to accelerate Rotary's development as an
  29 organization. Additionally, the rapid advancement of technology enables
  30 meetings to be held in the metaverse and automate translation and interpretaton.
