PURPOSE AND EFFECT

During an environmentally-focused meeting in January 2024, District 2150 solicited proposals from clubs and Rotary members regarding respect for the environment. One participant, supported by the members who attended the meeting and represented most clubs in the district, about 100 in all, proposed the addition of a fifth question to The Four-Way Test, namely, "Is it respectful of the environment?"

This addition would focus a club's attention on the importance of environmental stewardship every time the club and its members are developing a specific project and would allow them to make any necessary changes.
