PURPOSE AND EFFECT

- 17 Currently, The Rotary Foundation spends large amounts of funding every year on
- 18 excellent projects but is not necessarily promoting peace. Every project could
- 19 include an element of peacebuilding. A simple guide could be produced to
- 20 demonstrate to clubs and districts how a project can also be shown to support
- 21 positive peace. This will encourage clubs and districts to embrace 'Peace and
- 22 Understanding' in our projects and raise awareness of the need to develop peace
- 23 in every area of focus.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

- 24 If implemented, this resolution could have a financial impact on RI which cannot
- 25 be determined at this time. Cost would be dependent on the scope and extent of
- support provided by The Rotary Foundation to accomplish this goal.
