19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, in addition to friends and colleagues, the family members of these young people also take part in Rotary activities. They become members and potential contributors to The Rotary Foundation, and
23 24 25 26	WHEREAS, Rotary Kids and programs like it are already in existence throughout the world, but they urgently require the consistent oversight and support of RI, and
27 28	IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of RI consider officially recognizing Rotary Kids as a program of RI. (End of Text)
	PURPOSE AND EFFECT

This proposal seeks to make Rotary Kids an official program of RI. It will increase Rotary's membership and donations to The Rotary Foundation, thus rejuvenating the public image of our organization and helping to insure its survival into the future.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

1 2 3 4	If implemented, this resolution would result in an increase in expenses for RI. If Rotary Kids is administered as a structured program, expenses are estimated to be US\$330,000 per year for two staff members, production of materials, and postage. In addition, there is an initial cost of US\$20,000 for global trademark
5	research and registration.
7 8	RI recognizes Rotarian interest in supporting service clubs for younger children and encourages Rotarians to support such clubs in a way that is most appropriate
9	in local communities. For children who are 12 or older, RI encourages the
10	formation of Interact clubs where Rotary offers policy guidance, programmatic
11	support, and other resources.
