# **RESOLUTION 25R-25**

To request the RI Board to consider amending the provisions of the District Conference Voting Pilot

Proposer(s): Rotary Club of Sambalpur Central, District 3261, India

WHEREAS, any club having more than one vote in an election held during the
district conference is given a ballot indicating the number of votes to which that
particular club is entitled, and

WHEREAS, it has been noted that the identity of clubs having more than one vote is not kept confidential when such votes are tallied, and

WHEREAS, this is inconsistent with the standard of confidentiality set by RI for voting in district elections

IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary International consider amending the Rotary Code of Policies (June 2025) in Article 2, Club Membership and Administration, and specifically in subsection 2.130.4. as to the voting pilot established by the RI Board for districts in South Asia, as follows:

### Article 2. Club Membership and Administration

## 2.130. Pilot Projects

2.130.4. District Conference Voting Pilot

All districts in Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Nepal, and Pakistan. All voting at a district conference or district legislation meeting for all district elections through 2027-28. The district conference or district legislative meeting where the voting takes place shall be held within the district boundaries. During the voting procedure, each ballot shall be counted as one vote. Any club with more than one vote shall be provided with the number of ballots equal to the number of club votes. All such ballots shall be placed in an envelope provided by the election committee and shall be dropped in the ballot box. An independent observer appointed by the serving RI director shall open each envelop and verify that all votes are favoring the same candidate and shall mix the ballots in the ballot box.
