To request the RI Board to consider amending the provisions of the District Election Pilot

Proposer(s): Rotary Club of Sambalpur Central, District 3261, India

WHEREAS, clubs with a low membership count are considered to be active clubs
within the district even though such clubs may have only one or two members,
and
WHEREAS, such clubs perform poorly, engage in few activities, and contribute
little in relation to a club of average size, and
WHEREAS, because of their active status, these clubs are allowed to participate
in district elections, and
WHEREAS, clubs with extremely low membership are often created with the
intention of garnering votes for one or more favored candidates in district
elections and have been known to influence the outcome of such elections with
their preferential voting behavior
IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary
International consider amending the Rotary Code of Policies (June 2025) in
Article 2, Club Membership and Administration, and specifically in subsection
2.130.3. as to the election pilot established by the RI Board for districts in South
Asia, as follows:

2.130.3. District Election Pilot

The RI Board has established a district election pilot for all districts in Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines, and Sri Lanka for a six-year period beginning 1 July 2020 with following provisions:

- clubs chartered or reinstated during the Rotary year in which the election takes place, or from January to June of the year prior to the year in which the election takes place, will be ineligible to participate in any aspect of the election process;
- when a club ballot is necessary, the voting strength of each club will be based on the number of members on the July invoice of the year prior to

the year in which the club ballot takes place or the July invoice of the year in which the club ballot takes place, whichever is lower.;

active clubs with fewer than 13 members shall be ineligible to take part in any election activities or procedure of the district including voting at the district conference or district legislation meeting.
