## **PURPOSE AND EFFECT**

Despite their exemplary nature, several of Rotary's programs have not met with the success that they should. One of these is the Rotary Peace Centers program, which focuses on the peace, youth, and vocational Avenues of Service. The children of Rotarians are aware of these priorities and are naturally interested in this program. However, despite the low number of applications received for the program, they are ineligible to participate. Allowing Rotary members' children to apply would be a great source of motivation.
